MASTER'S ACCELERATED PROGRAM

Elevate your education with an advanced degree from NMSU. The Master's Accelerated Program allows academically qualified Aggies to earn both a bachelor's and master's degree in as little as five years.

Stay **Aggie!**

You already know NMSU is a great place to get an education. Why not stay Aggie and earn an advanced degree at NMSU?

The Master's Accelerated Program allows academically qualified students to apply up to 12 credits of undergraduate coursework (450 level or higher) toward a master's degree at NMSU and toward the bachelor's upperdivision electives.

Program details

- Participants must have an undergraduate GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Once you have completed 60 undergraduate credit hours, you can apply to the Master's Accelerated Program.
- During your junior and senior years, enroll in 450-level or higher courses. Courses must be passed with a B or higher in order to count as graduate degree credit.
- Up to 12 hours of coursework can be applied toward the completion of a master's degree.
- For tuition purposes, students will be considered undergraduates until they complete their undergraduate requirements. Once accepted to a Master's Accelerated Program at the junior or senior year, students will continue to be charged tuition and fees at the undergraduate rate and retain eligibility for undergraduate scholarships. Contact your financial aid advisor to discuss federal aid eligibility.
- Students must meet all application deadlines and program requirements in their undergraduate and graduate programs.
