

Program Details

- Participants must have an undergraduate GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Once you have completed 60 undergraduate credit hours, you can apply to the Master's Accelerated Program.
- You can enroll in 450 or 4500/500 or 5000-level or higher courses as advised by your Program Coordinator after completion of 60 credits. Courses must be passed with a B or higher in order to count as graduate degree credit.
- Up to 12 hours of coursework can be applied toward the completion of a master's degree.
- For tuition purposes, students will be considered undergraduates until they complete their undergraduate requirements. Once accepted to a Master's Accelerated Program at the junior or senior year, students will continue to be charged tuition and fees at the undergraduate rate and retain eligibility for undergraduate scholarships. Contact your financial aid advisor to discuss federal aid eligibility.
- Students must meet all program requirements to be conferred an undergraduate degree and must apply to be admitted to the master's program.

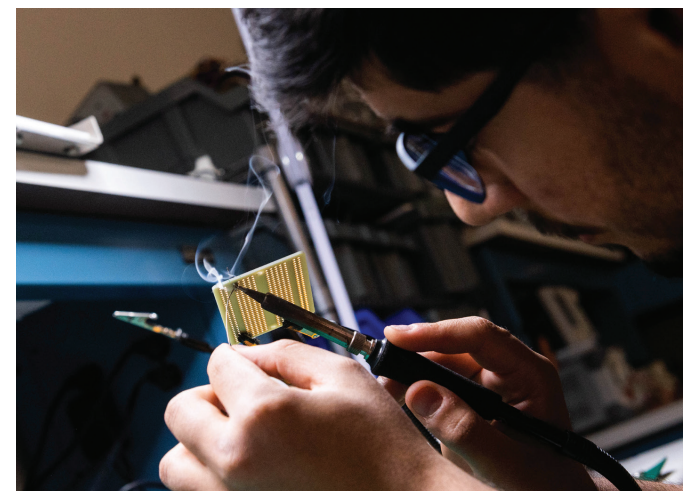
